Related Permits:**Comments:** On April 9, 2010, a phone interview was conducted with Scott Jones of Calumet Lubricants-Princeton in response to the self-reported heavy hydrotreated naphthenic distillate spill that occurred 4/8/2010 at the facility. Mr. Jones, Environmental Manager, stated that the cause of the release was due to overfilling a tank. He stated the release was contained within the firewall; ~ 200 gallons was released. He stated the free oil was vacuumed up and placed in the crude supply and that the residual was washed down and collected for placement in the wastewater system. He stated the contaminated soil was also removed. A site visit was conducted 4/13/2010 to verify the site clean-up with Mr. Jones. At the time of the inspection, the site appeared to be cleaned as described.
