On April 16, 2012, at approximately 11:34 hours, Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality Emergency Responder (LDEQ-ER) Nicole Hardy responded via phone to an incident reported by Tony Wysinger with Motiva Enterprises, LLC- Norco Refinery in Norco, La regarding a derailed tank car on the facility site, carrying Butadiene. According to Mr. Wysinger, the tank car's front wheels derailed and it was upright, and no damage had occurred to the car. No release had occurred. Motiva contacted Hulcher Services, Inc. to respond and place the car back onto the tracks. LDEQ-ER Nicole Hardy contacted Mr. Jason Barber (Hulcher manager on-site at Motiva) and advised he keep in touch regarding the placement of the railcar back onto the tracks, and please report when it was successfully completed. At 15:00 hours, according to Mr. Barber, the railcar was successfully placed back onto the tracks and no spill or damage to the car occurred.

There were no road closures, fires, injuries, or fatalities as a result of this incident. No further action by LDEQ Emergency Response at this time. NSH.
